On 10 January, Robyn, Francesca, Michael, Lyndon and Walter managed to untangle the unholy mess of the bird netting left by those who took the harvest last year in their haste to make off with the crop.

It was a painstaking morning's work removing all the debris, clips, etc. - Thanks Lyndon and Robyn.

Michael ran out the netting, each row requiring two lengths with a join in the middle - held together by clips. Ideally a job for people at least 2 metres tall. We were all pretty well buggered by midday in the heat so downed tools. The occasional bird has since penetrated the defence but nothing serious.

Before the "big wet" we sprayed sulphur and despite the high humidity seem to have avoided powdery mildew. We did have a scare when we saw "oil spots" suggesting Downy Mildew but, now think it only a bit of sulphur burn under the direct sun.



The ground is very moist and the rain gauge indicated about 60mm in the week

The grapes have coloured up significantly and all looks good for a picking in 2 to 3 weeks' time.
