We saw and tasted both Red and White wines from this new innovation coming out of England (Spanish entrepreneur – apparently). It passed the taste-test with flying colours.



Looks like glass but it's heaps lighter, and you guessed it, it is 100% recycled plastic bottle. But, designed to fit though a standard English letterbox opening. 40-something by 200-something millimetres.

Entrants and syndicates can only enter under one Club name and with a limit of 3 entries per category.

Each entry is to be clearly labelled on the front of the bottle with a stick-on label detailing

Label details required

wine or beer category

wine style or beer style

wine vintage

region of fruit and variety

blend and percentage detail if known

The Competition organisers will allocate an exhibitor number on each bottle.

Judging will take place on the night of the Inter-Club Competition by qualified judges.

Entries are returned to entrants on the night only and if unclaimed will be disposed of.
