## **Last Month's Events**

Dan, bless his cotton socks, was such a gentlemen for a short-notice discussion on one of his favorites - Emerging Varieties - White wines. We were treated to: Grillo; Arinto and Grüner Veltliner.

## Here's a bit of a summary:

**Grillo:** is a white Italian wine grape variety that withstands high temperatures and is widely used in Sicilian winemaking.

**Arinto:** is a white Portuguese wine grape planted primarily in the Bucelas, Tejo and Vinho Verde regions. It can produce high acid wines with lemon notes.

**Grüner Veltliner** is a white wine grape variety grown primarily in Austria, Hungary, Slovakia, and the Czech Republic. It is made into wines of many different styles - much is intended for drinking young in the bars serving new wine of Vienna, a little is made into sparkling wine, but some is capable of long aging.
