

> 1590 Litres in record time. Sales this year were down by ~11% as orders from the charity organisations had altered. meaning the Club members well and truly maintained their buying habits.

The Saturday pre-bottling of 30 cases for the

charities proceeded as usual, just like last year.

The main event on Sunday, was very well supported by Club members and helpers in unusually high numbers (20+), maybe it's because this is such a fun event.

With an (on the dot) 8:00am start, we managed the balance of the remaining 140+ cases in a little over 3 hours.

I have never seen the flow of wine from cannister through

to boxed-up bottles performed so swiftly, a truly a well-oiled machine of cooperation.

The BBQ was quickly started and we sat down to a lunch by noon, ....never heard of that before!
